Brigadier General Albert W. Schinz was born on February 27, 1919, in Ottawa, Illinois. He attended primary and high schools in Ottawa, then graduated from LaSalle-Peru-Oglesby Junior College (PHB), and later attended college at Illinois Wesleyan University, Bloomington, Illinois. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree (PHB).

In 1940, General Schinz entered the U. S. Army Air Corps as an Aviation Cadet. He completed Basic and Advanced Pilot Training at Kelly Field, Texas, in December 1940. Since that time, General Schinz has attended and completed courses at military schools which include the Command Staff Officers' Material Management Course and the National War College in Washington, D. C. Prior to World War II, General Schinz was a member of the 31st Pursuit Group at Selfridge Field, Michigan.

During World War II, General Schinz served in the Pacific Theater of operations, rising from the duty of flight commander in a fighter squadron based in New Guinea to squadron commander and then deputy Group Commander in 1943. During the later months of the war, General Schinz served as Director of Training for a fighter replacement unit.

In 1951, the General was serving as Chief, Fighter Branch Headquarters USAF, when he was assigned to the 51st Fighter Interceptor Wing in Korea as Deputy Wing Commander.

In July of 1952, the General returned to the United States to take over as the Ninth Air Force Deputy Director of Operations at Pope Air Force Base, North Carolina. In June of 1953, he once more went overseas, this time to Europe as Commander of the 50th Fighter Bomber Group. Leaving this post in March of 1954, he became the

Director of Operations and Training at Headquarters USAFE, at Wiesbaden, Germany.

From August of 1956 until August of 1959, General Schinz was assigned as Director and Chief of Staff for Operations at Headquarters Armed Forces Special Weapons Project, Washington, D. C.

From August 1959 until June 1960, the General attended the National War College and upon leaving the school, assumed command of the 401st Tactical Fighter Wing, England Air Force Base, Louisiana. From England AFB, the General was assigned to Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico, as Commander of the 832d Air Division.

General Schinz is a command pilot with over 4,000 hours of flying time.

General Schinz assumed command of the 836th Air Division on 15 January 1964.

His awards and decorations include: the Silver Star; the Legion of Merit (with one Oak Leaf Cluster); the Distinguished Flying Cross (with two Oak Leaf Clusters); the Air Medal (with two Oak Leaf Clusters); the Army of Occupation Ribbon (Germany); the Purple Heart; the American Defense Service Medal; American Campaign Medal; Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal; Commendation Ribbon; World War II Victory Medal; Distinguished Unit Badge; National Defense Service Medal; Korean Service Medal; Air Force Longevity Award (with four Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters); the United Nations Service Medal; and the U. S. Army Parachute Badge.

HISTORY

The 12th Tactical Fighter Wing came into being on November 20, 1940, when it was designated the 12th Bombardment Group (Light), by the War Department. It began operations in January of 1941, flying the B-18, B-23, and PT-17 aircraft.

After the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, the 12th was assigned the mission of patrolling the west coast of the United States. This mission was short in duration, however, as the 12th began transitioning into B-25 Mitchell Bombers in early 1942.

The threat of Japanese invasion of the United States mainland had subsided by the summer of 1942, thereby relieving the 12th of its coastal patrol mission.

August of 1942 saw the 12th moved to the Middle East and assigned to the Ninth Air Force. The 12th was now designated a medium bomber group, but was employed in a tactical role of close support and interdiction. Their new B-25's proved invaluable in the ultimate victory over Field Marshal Rommel's Afrika Korps. Air crews of the 12th bombed and strafed shipping, marshalling yards, and other targets in Egypt, Libya, Tunisia, Pantelleria, Lampedusa, Crete, Sicily, and Italy during the period of August 1942 to January 1944.

The 12th participated in two Allied drives against the Germans in the Middle East, the liberation of Egypt and the full liberation of North Africa. The latter drive occurred early in 1943 when two of the 12th's squadrons were attached to the Twelfth Air Force. For the 12th's contribution to the ultimate defeat of the German Forces in Africa, the 12th Bombardment Group (Medium) was awarded the Distinguished Unit Citation.

With Allied victory in sight in the Mediterranean Theater, the 12th was transferred to the Pacific Theater. Arriving in India in February of 1944, the 12th immediately started flying combat missions against the Japanese forces in Burma and China. As in Africa, the 12th flew tactical missions in support of the ground forces in the defeat of the enemy by attacking his communications, military installations and targets of opportunity.

With the victory over Japan achieved, the 12th Bombardment Group (Medium) returned to the United States in January of 1946 and was deactivated. But during their combat tours the men of the 12th had earned nine battle streamers; the Air Combat, EAME Theater; Egypt-Libya; Tunisia; Sicily; Naples;

Foggia; Rome-Arno; India-Burma; China Defensive; and Central Burma.

Almost ten years to the day from its initial activation the 12th was reactivated. The date was 1 November 1950. The Korean Conflict and increasing tension in the cold war dictated the need for more fighter units than the Air Force had. Thus, the 12th became the 12th Fighter-Escort Group, and began transitioning into the Republic F-84E at Turner AFB, Georgia, and later was transferred to Bergstrom AFB, Texas, where Strategic Air Command assumed control of the 12th.

While the 12th was based at Bergstrom AFB they were one of the first fighter units to engage in air to air refueling, developed techniques for delivery of nuclear weapons from fighter aircraft, and pioneered the concept of flying entire units of fighter-type aircraft across oceans on overseas deployments.


In late 1954, the 12th transitioned into the F-84F and continued operations at Bergstrom AFB until they were deactivated in January of 1958.

The 12th remained inactive until 25 April 1962, when it was again activated as the 12th Tactical Fighter Wing, being part of the extensive build up of TAC fighter forces. Being equipped with F-84F's again, the Wing began flying operations in July of 1962. The pilots (most of whom are still with the Wing) came primarily from three sources: The Air National Guard, the Air Training Command, and the Inactive Reserve. The higher echelon of command came from staff positions.

In spite of this apparent lack of experience, the 12th Tactical Fighter Wing quickly distinguished itself by becoming mission capable and assuming an alert commitment in the Cuban crisis. The 12th participated in competitive exercises with other fighter wings and won many honors. During the period of 1 April to 30 June 1963, the 12th was rated the best wing in TAC by the Management Control criteria.

As a result of their superior record the 12th was chosen to be the first wing in the Air Force to convert to the new Mach two, Phantom II, F-4C. Conversion began on 1 October 1963 when Colonel Harold M. McClelland, 12th Wing Commander, flew his first transition ride in the new McDonnell aircraft. Transition was quickly completed and the entire Wing was nearing operational status as of August 1964.



Levi R. Chase

Levi R. Chase was born in Cortland, New York, on 23 December 1917. He graduated from Cortland High School in 1936 and attended Syracuse University prior to entering the Army Air Corps as a flying cadet in February 1941.

His first assignment was to the 8th Pursuit Group at Mitchell Field. As a member of the 33rd Pursuit Group, Colonel Chase flew a P-40 from an aircraft carrier in the North African invasion and completed his first combat tour as the leading Tunisian Ace with ten victories. His next combat tour was in the China-Burma-India Theater in 1944 and 1945. He served as Deputy Commander of the Second Air Commando Group and Commander of the First Provisional Fighter Group and was credited with three Japanese fighters destroyed during this tour. He is the only American pilot to have shot down planes of all three Axis nations during World War II (German, Italian, and Japanese). During his tour in the CBI Theater, Colonel Chase planned and led the longest fighter-bomber raid ever staged by the U. S. Air Force—from a base in North Burma to Bangkok, Siam, and back. He was shot down while on a mission in Burma and wounded in a crash landing. He was rescued by two American pilots minutes before being captured by a Japanese patrol.

After World War II, Colonel Chase returned to civilian status as a New York State Veterans Counselor. Prior to his recall during the Korean Crisis, he attended two years at Albany Law School.

On being recalled, Colonel Chase served first as the Deputy Group Commander of the First Fighter Group and as the Commander, 63rd Fighter Interceptor Squadron, Oscoda, Michigan, prior to leaving for his third combat tour in Korea. His first assignment in Korea was as Deputy for Operations for the 51st Fighter Wing where he completed thirteen missions in the F-86 Sabrejet. He then assumed command of the 8th Fighter Group where he flew 120 missions in the F-80 Shooting Star. In December 1952, Colonel Chase assumed command of the 3600th Fighter Training Group at Luke Air Force Base, Arizona, where he organized the original "Thunderbirds." His next assignment was as a student at the Air War College, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama, and after graduation, in June 1956, Colonel Chase served three years as Team Chief of both the Air Defense Branch and Tactical Branch with the USAF Inspector General.

Colonel Chase recently returned from a tour in Europe with the 50th Tactical Fighter Wing at Hahn Air Base, Germany, and as Commander of the 7499th Support Group, Wiesbaden Air Base, Germany.

Among the awards and decorations Colonel Chase has received are the British Distinguished Flying Cross with bar, the Legion of Merit, the Silver Star with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the American Distinguished Flying Cross with four oak leaf clusters, the Air Medal with twenty oak leaf clusters, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, the Croix de Guerre, Army Commendation Medal and the Air Force Commendation Medal.
